In accordance with the Mission and Strategic Objectives of Kosovo Customs 2016-2018, developing policies of the Ministry of Finances and the Republic of Kosovo Government, to facilitate the legitimate trade and support the domestic product, as well as based on the conclusions from the meeting of the Risk Management Commission dated on 15.03.2016 and 23.03.2016, the Director General issues this:

BYLAW

TO REDUCE THE REGULAR EXPORT CONTROL PROCEDURE (EX1)

For declarations which directly pass on to the green channel by the Risk Analysis system

1. Declarations/consignments under the regular export regime (EX1) selected in the green channel, shall directly pass from the subject's premises in the destined BCP / exit BXP. The procedure of placing seals and verification on the exit will be performed at the destined BCP.
2. Declarations/consignments under the regular export regime (EX1) selected in the red channel shall be presented to the pertinent customs office in order to complete the regular control procedures.
3. Declarations/consignments under the regular export regime (EX1) selected in the green channel, will not immediately get the release status (L) for a specified time, in order to enable the shift leader or the head of pertinent customs office, in special cases to re-channel the declaration to another channel. Only after the period of time is passed and in case the subject is not re-channeled to another channel, the consignment may continue to the destined point.
4. As in the event of regular selection, the re-channeled declarations in the red channel shall be presented to the pertinent customs office in order to complete the regular control procedures. The work plan (local risk analysis) should not cause blockades for the goods movement.
5. Reduction of control procedure serves only for the regular export procedure (EX1).
6. In cases of excise goods export, the return of excise tax will be done only after the exporting subject along with certain documentation, presents the importing declaration from the country of destination.

7. All of the Regional Directorates and Central Directorates are ordered to notify their staff and shall attend for this bylaw to be implemented precisely from the moment of entry into force.

8. The bylaw shall enter into force on the day of its endorsement.
